CALL TO ORDER AND INTRODUCTIONS

OLD BUSINESS

Clarifying an agenda item from the January 2018 meeting; emergency work requires a ticket.

OPEN DISCUSSIONS REGARDING DAMAGE PREVENTION AWARENESS & COOPERATION

- The committee discussed the following issues;
 - o Emergency Tickets
 - Concern regarding Baltimore City after hour emergency response, which is contingent upon locate service agreement. Currently, Title 12 State Law does not provide for a less than two full day response on emergency tickets. Various Maryland owner-members respond accordingly.
 - Pinpoint inquired about missing emergency tickets, the Call Center asked for ticket number(s) for research. As a reference, the call center provides a daily ticket transmit to each district code providing a list of that day's transmitted ticket numbers by individual sequence number and the ticket type. If there are any issues regarding the ticket report and what the station received, the call center should be contacted immediately.
 - Water Pipe Break in Laurel, MD
 - Service disruption affected hundreds of Prince Georges County homes.
 - Compliments to BGE for doing an unbelievable job with such a massive undertaking.
 - Compliments to the staff at WSSC and especially David Wilkins (WSSC Customer Care Advocate).
 - Plumbers Assoc. & Crossbores
 - Wash Gas attended a plumber's association general meeting building good will, stronger relationships while providing relevant awareness of crossbores.

- The Authority stated that the plumbers association has had a presence at rewrite meetings since the January DPC meeting where crossbores was a topic of discussion.

Fred Ferrer, Maryland Coordination & Analysis Center, provided information on protecting critical infrastructure.

- In wake of 9/11 attack, an anti-terrorism advisory council (ATAC) was set up. Needed a fusion center to create information-sharing protocols. ATACis made of federal, state, and local associations.
- Maryland Coordination and Analysis Center (MCAC) serves as the focal point between federal, state, local, and private sector partners in gathering, analysis, and dissemination of criminal and homeland security information to help keep Maryland safe.
- Terror attacks happening on continuous modes of transportation latest has been vehicles and large vans.
- Department of Homeland Security (DHS) has 16 different sectors and the concern is all of that infrastructure.
- Private sector concern is of extreme importance because most infrastructure is owned and operated by private entities (Ex: Verizon, BGE, etc.) Fred sets up partnerships/relationships with these companies.
