# **CALL TO ORDER AND INTRODUCTIONS**

Chairman Kevin Woolbright called the regular monthly meeting to order at 9:33 a.m. followed by the customary self-introductions. Meeting attendees are listed on the last page of these minutes.

**SAFETY PRESENTATION** – Anne Arundel County First Responders, Presented by Chief James Wilkison

**James Wilkison** has 25 years of experience in the fire service and is a Division Chief with the Anne Arundel County Fire Department. He is currently the "D" shift commander that oversees 31 fire stations that provide fire, EMS, HAZMAT, rescue, and marine emergency response. He is a national registered paramedic, has a bachelor's degree in fire service management, and has attended the National Fire Academy. Chief Wilkison spoke about;

Priority of First Responders;

- Isolate area
- Evaluate as necessary
- Support local utility owner/operator

The Anne Arundel Fire Departments respond to;

- Fires
- Gas order and leak reports
- Hazardous material conditions

#### And provide;

- Technical rescues
- Emergency medical services
- Marine operations

The county has 31 stations, 850 career personnel, 450 volunteers and have responded to over 80,000 incidents in 2017. Gas related incidents include; 685 gas odors in structures, 367 odor/gas/smoke in area and 184 natural gas line strikes.
