Minutes of the meeting for April 24, 2018 Meeting hosted by Miss Utility in Hanover, MD Prepared by Dora Parks, Secretary

CALL TO ORDER AND INTRODUCTIONS

Chairman Kevin Woolbright called the regular monthly meeting to order at 9:30 a.m. followed by the customary self-introductions. Meeting attendees are listed on the last page of these minutes.

OPEN DISCUSSIONS REGARDING DAMAGE PREVENTION AWARENESS & COOPERATION

The committee discussed the following matters;

- Newly installed facilities not being located.
 - o Advised to call the call center to identify the utility company and provide contact information.
 - Members agreed new facilities may not make the formal record keeping for months and may not be energized for periods of time. Marc Haines (BGE) stated if the concern is in BGE territory to call 410-470-6698 and an inspector will be dispatched.
 - Other locating companies stated they mark what facilities are identified on their records.
 - o Some utilities hold their subcontractor installers responsible for locating the utility during the installation process through their contract administration.
- PEPCO reported plumber damage due to no tickets and no permits. One incident resulted in a sewer pipe being cross bored into an electric facility, resulting in raw sewage leaking into five PEPCO manholes.
 PEPCO will hold contractor responsible for damage to PEPCO collapsed duck banks if undermined during construction and trench box installations.
- Discussion on what a Dispute notice is and if member reports are available;
 - o All members have access to Ticket Check reporting which provides data on statused ticket codes.
- Comcast (or any owner-member) being added to tickets
 - o All contractors should understand which owner-members are being notified on their ticket(s)
 - o If an owner-member needs to be added to the processed ticket, contact the Miss Utility Helpdesk at 410-712-0056; the Helpdesk will review the ticket and mapping to ensure appropriate processing. If needed, the district code will be added and transmitted to the district's receiving

station. Miss Utility will also contract the member directly regarding the request to add their district to a ticket so the district mapping can be reviewed by the member and changes made where necessary. There is no need to generate a new ticket number, this will have a negative impact on other utilities and locators.

- Pre-calling for next day emergency work
 - After committee discussion on this topic, the owner-members stated pre-calling for emergency work is not an acceptable practice.
- Update tickets do the locators see the remarks/comments?
 - The ticket is a collection of work site data and locators should review the entire ticket's information as transmitted by Miss Utility.
 - o Do not add the extent of work or scope of work to the remarks section, use the appropriate field.
 - o Remove the remarks/comments when updating the ticket if they no longer apply.
 - o If adding an attachment via ITIC, it was suggested to make note of the attachment in the remarks/comments section.
- ITIC City/Place field confusion
 - o Current ITIC pop-up for CDP city/place alert confusing to users, suggested using different alert language for better user understanding.
 - o ITIC provides the mapping city/place names when the cursor hoovers over the address.

- Use Safety Meetings to reinforce procedures and combat complacency
