Minutes of the meeting for February 23, 2021 Zoom Meeting hosted by Miss Utility in Hanover, MD Prepared by Susan Sullivan

CALL TO ORDER AND INTRODUCTIONS

Chairman Kevin Woolbright called the regular monthly meeting to order at 9:30 a.m. via Zoom. There were 56 zoom attendees.

OPEN DISCUSSION

John Shuffler (Civil Construction) thanked Utiliquest for their assistance in resolving recent ticket issues. He then inquired about continuing ticket status and marking delays. Mike Burns (Utiliquest) provided feedback on current efforts to minimize delays. He asked that escalation issues be brought to the attention of Utiliquest management. Marc Haines (BGE) provided feedback reinforcing their commitment to minimizing delays as well. Both gentlemen provided their email for further communication.

Mark Wetzler (Belfast Valley Contractors) stated that contacting DDOT using the phone numbers provided for by the ticket were unsuccessful. Dora Parks (Miss Utility), referring to DC law, shared that if direct contact with DDOT is unsuccessful, then contact with the Attorney General for the District of Columbia is the appropriate next step.

Jim Barron (MD Authority) and Kevin Woolbright (DPC Chairman) both emphasized the positive influence good communication has in de-escalating issues that may arise between stakeholders.

Dora Parks recognized and thanked owner members and contract locators for their effort in responding to and resolving issues brought to their attention by homeowners even when said issues are outside of their scope of responsibility.

Scott Moore (Colonial Pipeline) expressed the importance of valid ticket user contact information being provided for on all tickets.

Bill Jackson (MDOT) provided the ticket resolution hotline for MDOT/SHA - 410-572-5264.

MISS UTILITY CALL CENTER

- ITICnxt: Susan Sullivan (Miss Utility) provided an overview of ITICnxt's user homepage dubbed: My Tickets. Features highlighted: Service territory filter; user settings; view ticket map; page settings and the *I want to* filter. Please contact Susan at <u>ssullivan@missutility.net</u> with any questions.
- Damage Reporting: Dora Parks (Miss Utility) provided YTD data through January 2021 of reported damages in MD/DC.
 - 48 utility damages (10 mains and 38 services)
 - 29.17% due to no call or valid ticket
 - 16.67% due to hitting a marked line
 - 37.50% due to incorrect locate marks
 - 16.67% due to other root causes
- DC Title 34 Law Update

The Mayor signed new bill in January 2021. Highlights include:

- DCRA to receive a copy of all tickets.
- At least 96 hours but no more than 10 days prior to proposed excavation or demolition, notification to owner members must be provided.
- Member response is 72 hours.
- Clear evidence and/or observed discrepancy is now law.
- Civil penalties have increased.
- Allows Mayor to provide public education programs and to establish an advisory committee among other provisions.

MARYLAND AUTHORITY

MARYLAND TITLE 12 RE-WRITE

- Governor Hogan vetoed SB0877 on May 7, 2020.
- The veto override was recently approved by the Maryland Senate and the Maryland House of Delegates.
- SB 877 will become law 30 days after the final override vote on February 11, 2021.


