After a question about Maryland SHA and mapping by Dominic Pope (Gaines and Company), Ryan Beaudoin (Skyline) confirmed that recent updates have improved ticket location and statusing.

Guy Miller (Commercial Utilities) applauded the ability to add a temporary excavator to a primary ticket but noted that it was not working on emergency tickets unless the temporary was added within three (3) hours of a ticket being processed. Jennifer stated that this was a known issue and being corrected. (Issue had been fixed).
